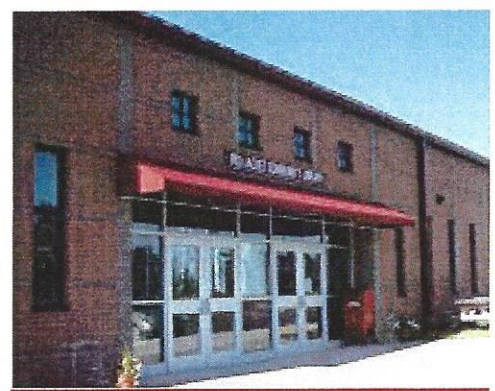

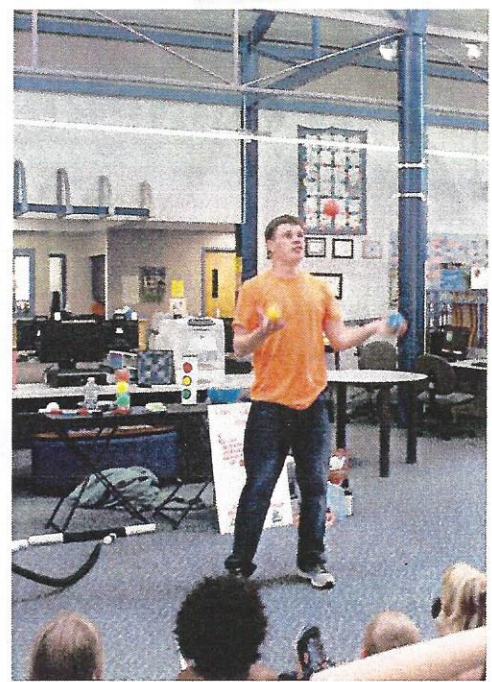
#### Mission

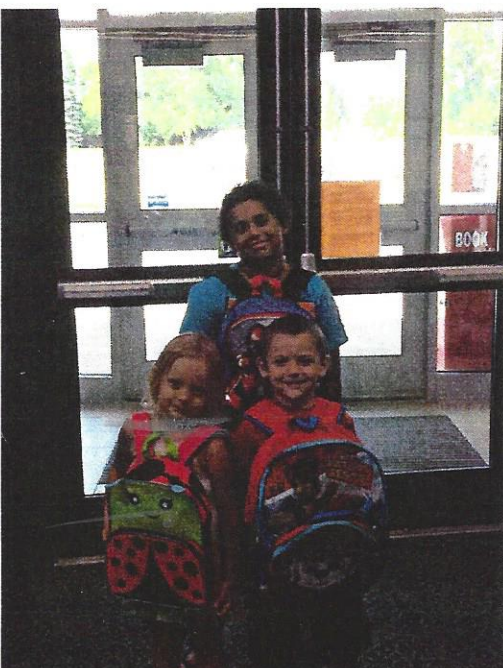
# Library Highlights:

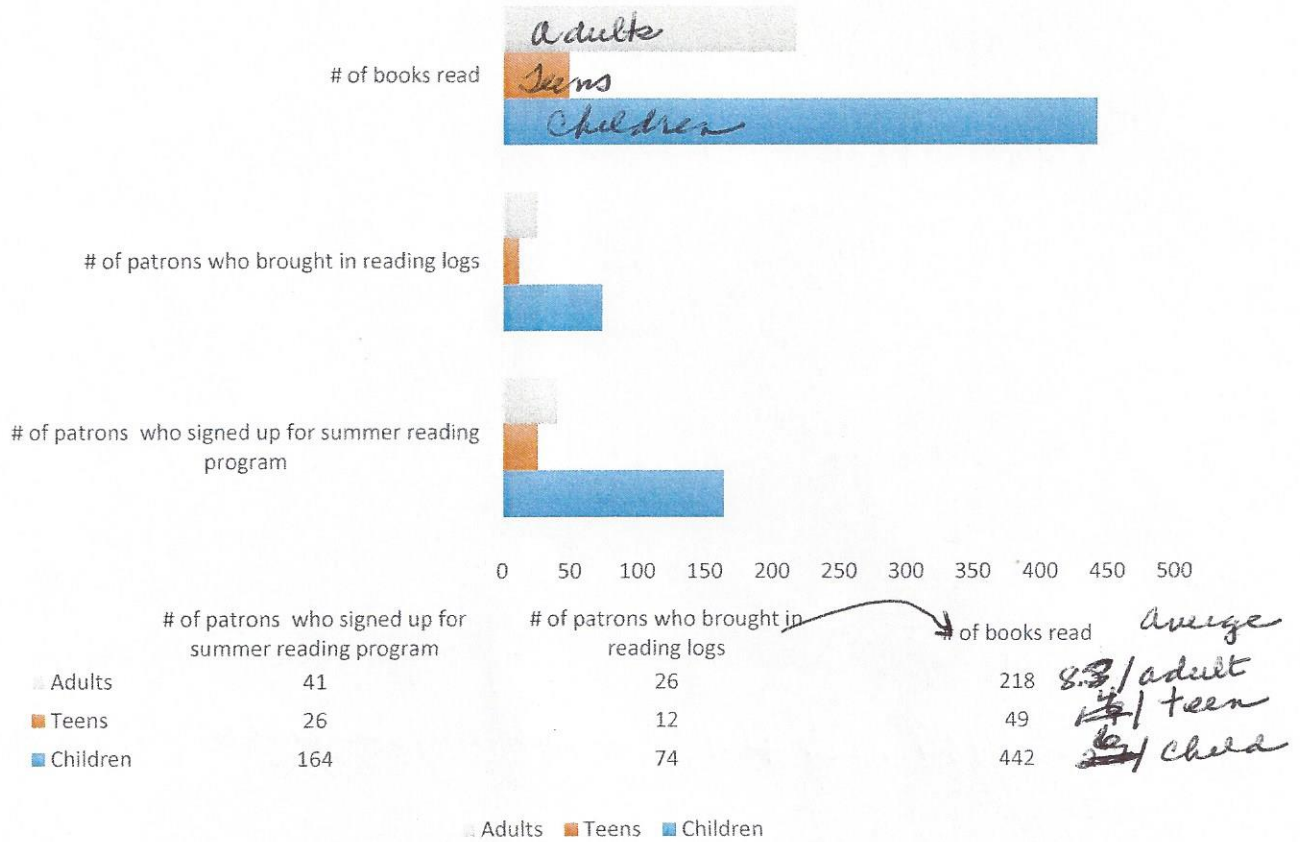
