

In 2022, Red Jacket Community Library made the decision to move out of the shared use facility in the school due to increased costs and reduced benefits. We moved into a temporary location which has allowed the Library to be in compliance with the NYS Division of Library Development minimum standards in regards to our open hours, which previously were not being met due to the restricted hours of access at the school.

The new location has given the Library the opportunity to set our own hours, allowing for daytime access to the library and offer more diverse programming. At our new location, the library has put an emphasis on preschool aged programming, offering multiple story times and early literacy programs. We offer a space for teens to come after school and offer an increased number of teen programs. We

offer opportunities for adults to socialize through our multiple craft programs and emphasize healthy lifestyles with our hiking and walking programs, as well as our Snap-Ed NY cooking program. The Director and Library Board of Trustees continues to collaborate with many community organizations, pursue grant opportunities and support fundraising through the Friends of the RJCL.

The Library welcomed some new faces, as well as familiar faces into new roles. Jordan Schneider, who has been part of the library team since 2021, was appointed Library Director. Meghan was appointed in the fall as our new Youth Services Coordinator and Rachel as our Adult Services Coordinator. Sam, who joined our team in 2021, was appointed as our full time clerk, taking on circulation, cataloging and Teen Services.

We also welcomed new trustees, Kathleen Honchen, Heather Baxter, Amanda Bement, and Susan Johnson.

Patsy, a library clerk for Red Jacket Community Library, retired in July after serving our community for over 21 years. We were saddened by her passing in September. Through memorial donations made in her name we have purchased a new book shelf.

In 2023, we hope to find a forever home for the library in a permanent location and reestablish our full collection. We also hope to increase the amount of programs offered and increase our patronage and circulation. We look forward to continuing to serve our community and welcome you into the library!
